Tournament Rules & Information

League Operators:

- Provide a current list of players' standing to confirm eligibility and player ranking status based on the ACS Nationals Rating System. Jack and Jill Scotch Doubles (1 male & 1 female)
 - If a player **does not** have an ACS rating, we can use an established Fargo rating of:
 - **Recreation** (Fargo: 0 - 795) or (CSR: 0 - 3,100)
 - **Standard** (Fargo: 796 - 945) or (CSR: 3,101 - 3,300)
 - **Open** (Fargo: 946 - 1,095) or (CSR: 3,301 - 3,500)
 - **Advanced** (Fargo: 1,096 - 1,245) or (CSR: 3,501 - 3,700)
 - **Master** (Fargo: 1,246 - 1,360) or (CSR: 3,701 - 3,850)

Races:

- The highest rated player on the team is the team rating.
 - Race to 4 - Recreational
 - Race to 4 - Standard
 - Race to 5 - Open
 - Race to 6 - Advanced
 - Race to 7 - Master

Note: If the tournament goes to 1 less on the back side the minimum will be race to 3.

Please comply with the following process.

Tournament Entry Details/Process:

- To qualify for the "Early Entry" rate, players must submit their entry forms and payment to their local League Operator. The **League Operators** must email team entry forms to ACS Arizona by **September 12th, 2026**. Email entries and questions to acsa.arizona@gmail.com, or call (602) 505-6491.
- Teams who show up the day of the tournament without prior notice, given to ACS Arizona by September 12th, 2026, will be charged the ON-SITE late fee of \$20.00 plus entry.

Rules of this tournament:

- 1) All monies (minus the registration) will be paid back to players.
- 2) \$20 Green Fees for the two day event.
- 3) ACS National Tournament rules will apply to this tournament; 45 seconds per shot.
- 4) Double elimination (race for losing side will depend on the number of entries).
- 5) Rack and Break your own.
- 6) Flip for the first break, then alternate.
- 7) 8-BALL on the break is NOT a win. Scratch on 8-Ball is not a loss as long as the 8-Ball stays on the table.
- 8) NO PHONE CALLS or TEXTING during your game.
- 9) NO headsets.
- 10) Matching team shirts, collared polo style preferred but not required (will allow matching shirts w/ bar logo).
- 11) All matches are to be played – if you do not play you forfeit your spot (NO splitting the money).
